## CHARTER COMMISSION

Should residents vote to move towards Home Rule, a Charter Commission composed of community members will be formed. The Commission will be tasked to write the Town Charter, which is the document our local government will operate under.

Similar to how Trustees are selected, Commission members are elected by residents. Candidates will

need to go through necessary steps to get their name on the ballot.
